NON-SPREADING EVERGREEN BAMBOO

LANDSCAPE USES AND IDEAS:

- BEAUTIFUL EVERGREEN PRIVACY SCREEN
- SPECIMEN / FOCAL POINT PLANT
- TROPICAL LUSH APPEARANCE
- UNIQUE + INTERESTING PLANT
- PROVEN PERFORMANCE RECORD
- BIRD AND WILDLIFE SHELTER
- LOOKS LIKE ORNAMENTAL GRASS

GROWTH IN THE LOWER MIDWEST (ZONES 5-7):

- MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF 3 TO 6 FEET MAY BE ACHIEVED IN 5 TO 10 YEARS.
- RHIZOMES ARE CLUMPING; NOT INVASIVE LIKE THE BAMBOO YOU MAY KNOW.
- BAMBOO IS RESISTANT TO DROUGHT AND HEAT AFTER ESTABLISHED.
- BAMBOO IS NOT TROUBLED BY ANY DISEASES, INSECTS OR ANIMALS
- BAMBOO WILL THRIVE IN FULL SHADE TO PART SUN IN MOIST TO DRY SOILS.
- NEW SHOOTS DISPLAY A BEAUTIFUL REDDISH-ORANGE LEAF SHEATH.
- WINTER HARDY TO -20F (ZONE 5-6), LEAF BURN MAY BEGIN AT -5F

ESTABLISHMENT PERIOD:

- WATER AND FERTILIZE DURING THE FIRST YEAR, THEN ONLY DURING DROUGHT
- DON'T PLANT IN CONSTANTLY WET SOILS. WILL TAKE DRY SHADE IS ESTABLISHED.

MAINTENANCE AND SPREAD CONTROL:

- NO CONTROL IS NEEDED; GROWS LIKE A CLUMP FORMING ORNAMENTAL GRASS.
- THIS IS A VERY LOW MAINTENANCE PLANT NEEDING NO PRUNING AND LITTLE CARE
