



HARDSCAPE CONSTRUCTION



A hardscape is any permanent stone structure or component of your landscape. Low Maintenance Landscape specializes in the art of building hardscapes from natural stone. We design hardscapes to add function, usefulness, added outdoor living space, and long lasting beauty to your property. We can build any of the following; natural flagstone patios, stepping stone paths, antique brick patios, stone retaining walls, seatwalls, stone outcroppings, stone edging, dry riverbeds, accent boulders, stone fire pits and fireplaces.





NATURAL FLAGSTONE PATIOS

At Low Maintenance Landscape, flagstone patio construction work is the best quality you will find. There are several characteristics to a good quality patio and if you scrimp on even one of them, the entire patio is compromised. Our flagstone patios are constructed using 2-3" thick, high quality hardened sandstone slabs measuring up to 5' across. The spacing between stones averages only 1/4" and is constructed on a 6" thick base composed of AB-3 and sand. This may sound technical, but we believe you should know all the details before investing thousands of dollars in a

beautiful flagstone patio that will last a lifetime.

STONE RETAINING WALLS AND SEATWALLS

Sloping sites can present real problems including runoff and erosion. It can also be challenging to find ways to use this property. Sites like this can really benefit from the construction of a retaining wall to provide more level planting and recreation areas. We construct beautiful natural stone retaining walls using a variety of stone ranging from naturalistic to more formal. A seatwall is basically a freestanding or retaining wall with a flat surface built into it for sitting. These beautiful features create an ideal setting for entertaining your family and friends.





NATURAL STONE OUTCROPPINGS AND BOULDERS

We have an eye for creating realistic looking stone outcroppings similar to what you'll see in nature. A well constructed stone outcropping serves the purpose of a retaining wall by slowing runoff and reducing erosion. The difference is that an outcropping looks more natural; like it has always been there.





STONE FIREPITS AND OUTDOOR FIREPLACES

We design and construct fire pits and fireplaces that help create the feel of an outdoor room. An outdoor fire feature will provide you a cozy and romantic place to harness the warmth and light of an open fire. Your kids will enjoy the fun and responsibility of having campfires and roasting marshmallows.







DECORATIVE CONCRETE

We can design and subcontract high quality decorative concrete patios. We usually recommend a natural earthlike slate texture and brown or beige color.

STONE EDGING

Stone edging can be installed around a bed area to help give it structure and form. It also helps keep mulch in your bed on sloped sites. Many of our beds are fine with or without edging but if you prefer a border, we prefer the beauty of natural stone.






WOOD CONSTRUCTION, DECKS, FENCES, PERGOLAS


last for decades. Our systems are built with PVC pipe and Rain Bird® heads. To avoid costly damage later, all pipes are buried extra deep.



DRAINAGE SYSTEMS



When it rains, you may experience standing water around your flower beds, lawn, patio or near your home's foundation. Our team of professionals at Low Maintenance Landscape can design and install the appropriate drainage solutions to fix these problems. A "french drain" is a perforated pipe surrounded with gravel. It is designed to catch water from a large yard area and channel it away from the house foundation. A "drain extension" is a buried solid pipe designed to catch water from a concentrated source like a gutter downspout and channel it away from the house foundation.

RAIN GARDENS

Rain gardens offer a way for homeowners to protect our environment and reduce flooding. A rain garden is a shallow depression that is planted with native wetland or wet prairie wildflowers and grasses. Rain gardens are strategically located to capture runoff from impervious surfaces such as roofs, driveways and roads. These landscaping features help create beautiful green spaces while absorbing water, reducing runoff, protecting water quality and preventing floods.



DRY RIVER BEDS

We construct stone dry river beds that recreate what you would find in nature. It is a beautiful landscaping approach used in sloping areas to help control erosion. Most of the time when the feature is dry, the stone


will be the focal point. But when we do get that heavy rain storm, it will transform into a beautiful natural flowing stream.






WATERGARDENS AND WATERFALLS


A water garden or waterfall will usually be the main visual attraction in the garden. This focal point will also create the soft relaxing sound of trickling water as you work or play. Constructing a good quality water garden is one of the most difficult niches in the field of landscape architecture. Our water gardens are carefully designed not to fail. We are always on the look out for potential problems; water will always try to find a way out as gravity is constantly working against us. Our water gardens will contain many extra features that inexperienced contractors may simply forget or omit because of cost. For example, all inside surfaces are lined with stone; this prevents accidental liner puncture when a neighbor's dog jumps in. In our decade of experience, we know all the tricks of mastering water.





GROUNDCOVERS FOR DRY SHADE AND HILLSIDES

A groundcover area is simply a mass planting of one type of plant. This serves the same purpose of a lawn grass; to fill large areas of landscape space. Mowing and maintaining that water thirsty lawn under your large shade tree or on a hillside is expensive and time consuming! In the long run, you are fighting a losing battle in which the tree roots will out-compete lawn for water and nutrients. In general, groundcovers are tolerant of a wide range of soil types. By looking at your soil type, we can recommend the perfect groundcover even for that "nothing will grow there" soil. If you are having problems with barren areas in your



BROADLEAF EVERGREEN TREES AND SHRUBS

Broadleaf evergreen trees and shrubs provide much-needed winter color in cold climates. Broadleaf evergreens provide a few key advantages over coniferous evergreens. Broadleaf evergreens offer superior disease resistance, bright green, red or purple winter color, plenty of cold hardiness,



HARDY TROPICAL GARDENS

Hardy tropical plants create the feeling of a lush, relaxing, low stress environment. These plantings create the mood of being in a warm, happy, tropical place. The typical cold hardy tropical will have either large leaves, large flowers, bold texture or lots of contrast. Surprisingly, many of these plants such as needle palm and hardy banana

will grow here if placed in the right microclimate! Typically being zone 6 or 7 plants, they are perfectly happy next to a hot south or west wall that will burn most plants that aren't heat tolerant. They can be treated like normal perennials, only requiring extra mulch to survive the winter.

EVERGREEN BAMBOO SCREENS AND WALLS

You have reason to be skeptical of planting bamboo because it can take over your yard. Many homeowners and inexperienced landscapers have improperly planted bamboo and given it a bad reputation. Low Maintenance Landscape is one of the only companies with the knowledge and experience of how to contain bamboo in the landscape and utilize all of its wonderful assets.





A large evergreen bamboo screen can completely hide the view of a neighbor's house, block traffic noise from a busy street and provide shelter from wind. Bamboo is often used to create evergreen privacy walls

because there is no other plant that can match the density of bamboo. We often recommend bamboo for dry shade areas under large trees where no other evergreen will grow. A grove is usually contained with a plastic underground rhizome barrier. Bamboo is also used in open lawn areas where it can be maintained by normal mowing around the perimeter.




BUFFALO GRASS LAWNS

Buffalo grass is the native choice for an environmentally friendly lawn. Unlike fescue or bluegrass, this lawn grass uses only 1/4 inch of water per week to stay green. It only needs mowing every 3-6 weeks. Buffalo grass is dense, fine textured, and maintains a beautiful medium green color during the growing season. It does best where it gets full sun, dry clay soil, and a taller mowing height of 4".

NATIVE PRAIRIE GARDENS

Many of our gardens are designed to survive and open, windswept, full sun prairie environments. Native plants are often best adapted for these harsh conditions. Most prairie natives require no extra water once established. Native prairie gardens also friendly to butterflies, bees, and birds.

BERM CONSTRUCTION AND PLANTING

Well constructed berms provide interest to an otherwise flat landscape. Berms also provide height, noise screening and wind protection. They also help direct traffic and create physical barriers to automobiles. A well proportioned and properly planted berm will require a lot of soil to create a focal point; perfect if you have a leftover pile of dirt from a construction project.
